## Before the dance:

- Notify the Super Square Head, Stephanie Stevens, (408-871-9525 of any needed changes to assigned dates.
- YOU DO NOT NEED TO BRING ICE!
- On scheduled night, the designated Square Heads should arrive by 6:30 PM.and stay until clean up is finished around 9:45 PM. A Katydids member with a key will open the doors and will secure the hall at end of evening.
- Place "Caution" signs (located in the storage/supply room along with a map) in designated areas of the parking lot where there are tripping hazards.
- Make ice water using provided cubes in freezer and make coffee.
- Set up drinks and supplies on counter.
- Place leftover snacks, napkins and flyers on tables at back of the hall.


## During Club dance:

- Set up the sign in table and welcome everyone as they enter.
- Collect a $\mathbf{\$ 5 . 0 0}$ donation from each guest and have them sign in. "Regular" guests sign the prepared sheet, new guests sign the guest book.
- In the green box, there is an envelope with petty cash for making change.
- Offer raffle tickets: 5 tickets for $\$ 1.00$.
- In the green box, there are envelopes for keeping track of money collected during the evening.
- Divide the raffle proceeds with $50 \%$ to the Club, $50 \%$ to the winner. (Note: odd dollar goes to the winner!)
- Check that water and cups do not run out during the evening.
- After announcements and raffle, feel free to dance except for the last tip (unless you are needed to fill a square) when you will need to be putting things away and cleaning up


## After the dance:

- If Treasurer is not present, pass monies collected to any Executive Board Member.
- Pack up the sign-in items, leftover snacks and flyers. Empty and dry coffee pot and cooler and pack up other supplies and return them to the shelf in storage room. Wipe counter and tables where needed.
- Empty garbage can if more than half full. The dumpster is located in the side parking lot.
- Sweep up crumbs from the floor as needed.

Thank you all for expressing concerns about Louise. I took her back into El Camino Hilton on June 9 after noticing that she was acting and talking irrational. Hospital ER's do a very good thorough job of testing when warranted. I told them she was dehydrated but they still did EKG
for stroke and blood tests. I felt for Louise because they had a very difficult time trying to get blood samples and start an IV (a human pin cushion). Even when she is normal her veins are difficult to find but dehydrated person is worse as the veins tend to collapse. An ER doctor finally inserted a tube in a vein located near the right collar bone. She was admitted and again is in her $3^{\text {rd }}$ week at El Camino. A number of new tests were done but all proved to be negative. I told the doctor he would not hurt my feelings if he sought $2^{\text {nd }}, 3^{\text {rd }}$ and $4^{\text {th }}$ opinions which he said he has been doing. Teaching at Stanford helps him access to many fellow doctors. So for the moment he is going to concentrate back to the original diagnosis of microscopic colitis of about a year ago. I am now more aware of the importance of and problems dehydration may cause. Be sure you remain hydrated with water and electrolytes especially during the hot weather coming up...

Congratulations to Don Village who was honored by his company, Spectra-Physics, for attaining 50 years of service for that Santa Clara company as their R \& D Machinist on June 20, 2016 (that's from 1966). He has been the only machinist for the whole company for several years. ## From the Kitchen of Pat Angotti -

## TRIPLE-CHOCOLATE CAKE, \#2

Makes 2 coffee cakes
Preheat oven to $350^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$
1-18.25 oz pkg devil's food cake mix
$1-3.9 \mathrm{oz} \mathrm{pkg}$ chocolate instant pudding mix
2 c. sour cream
1 c. butter, softened
5 large eggs
1 tsp vanilla extract
3 c. semisweet chocolate chips, divided
1 c. white chocolate chips
1 c. pecans, toasted \& chopped

- Beat first 6 ingredients at low speed with an electric mixer 30 seconds or just until moistened; beat at medium speed 2 minutes. Stir in 2 cups semisweet chocolate chips; pour batter evenly into 2 greased and floured 9 -inch square cake pans.
- Bake at $350^{\circ}$ for 25 to 30 minutes or until a wooden pick inserted in center comes out clean. Let cool completely in pans on wire racks
- Microwave white chocolate chips in a glass bowl at HIGH 30 to 60 seconds or until chips melt., stirring at 30 -second intervals until smooth. Drizzle evenly over cakes; repeat procedure with remaining 1 cup semisweet chocolate chips. Sprinkle pecans over cakes. Cut into squares or wedges.

## TROPICAL DUMP CAKE

Preheat oven to $350^{\circ} \mathrm{F}$
Grease a 13 x 9 pan
2-20oz cans crushed pineapple, undrained
$1-181 / 4 \mathrm{oz} \mathrm{pkg}$ white cake mix
$1 / 2$ c. butter or margarine, cut up
2 c. pecans, toasted
ice cream or whipped topping

- Drain 1 can crushed pineapple and spread all of pineapple on bottom of a lightly greased 13 x 9 pan.
- Sprinkle cake mix over the frit
- Dot evenly with butter.
- Sprinkle with pecans.
- Bake for $45-50$ minutes or until golden and bubbly.
- Serve with cice cream.
