Before the dance:

- Notify the Co-Super Square Head, Lloyd Darknell, 408-482-9320 of any needed change of duty assignment dates.
- Purchase and bring 6-8 lbs ice for the water cooler.
- On scheduled night, the designated Square Heads should arrive **by 6:30 PM.** A Katydid with a key will arrive to open the doors.
- Sweep floor as necessary.
- Set up tables and chairs as needed. *Note: Chairs* should be set up in a horseshoe shape with an opening at the back for access to refreshments.
- Make ice water.
- Start hot water for tea and coffee.

During Club dance:

- Welcome everyone at the sign-in table.
- Offer raffle tickets, 5 tickets for \$1.00.
- Have guests sign guest book and collect a \$4.00 donation per guest.
- Divide the raffle proceeds 50% to the Club, 50% to one single "prize" cup.
- Check that water and cups do not run out.
- If Treasurer is not present, pass monies collected to any Executive Board Member.

After the dance -

- ALL MEMBERS: *Clean up!!* Help pack up supplies and jugs and put into the Club cupboard. *Remove non-recyclable trash accidentally tossed into the designated recycle bins.* Take the trash bags out to the dumpster located in the side parking lot.
- Sweep or wet mop the floor as necessary.
- NOTE: tables must go into closet FIRST (remember the Caller's table, too), then the chair "rack".
- Notify co-Super Square Head, Carol Headman, 408-264-9606 of any supplies that are needed.

PARTNER ROTATION BOARD


Have you been using the Partner Rotation Board that **Gary Hinze** has been so kind to provide each Friday night? It is an easy, reliable way for dancers to find a partner for each tip and at the same it facilitates those whose regular paratner is absent as well as those who wish to dance with different partners. Mixing skill levels gives us all an opportunity to become stronger dancers.

Here are some things to remember:

- 1. You can join or leave the "board" at any time.
- 2. To join, write your name as sit appears on your badge on a white magnetic strip with the dry-erase marker. Depending on which position you wish to dance, place your name on the board at the end of the "man" or "lady" columns. Please note: *Leaving your name on the board is a promise to dance the next tip with whomever is matched with your name.* Do not be RUDE and leave someone without a partner!
- 3. BEFORE each tip begins, check the board to find the name next to yours. That person will be your parnter for that tip.
- 4. If you want to leave the partner rotation, after the last tip, immediately remove your name from the board. When a name is removed, the name at the bottom is brought up to fill the gap.

Thank you, **Gary**, for all your time and effort to get this system set up for us!

PUMPKIN CHOCOLATE CHIP CAKE

Serves 16

Preparation time: 10 minutes Baking time: 42-46 minutes

Oil spray for pan Flour for dusting the pan 1 pkg. (18.25 oz.) plain yellow cake mix 1 can (15 oz; 1 3/4 c.) pumpkin 1/4 c. water

2 large eggs

- 2 t. pumpkin pie spice
- 2 t. baking soda
- 1 c. semisweet chocolate chips
- 1 c. finely chopped pecans
- 1 T. confectioners' sugar for garnish
- 1. Place rack in the center of the oven and preheat the oven to 350°F. Ligtly spray a 12cup bundt pan with vegetable oil spray, then dust with flour. Shake out the excess flour. Set pan aside.
- 2. Place cake mix, pumpkin, water, eggs, pumpkin pie spice, and baking soda in a large mixing bowl. Blen with an electric mixer on low speed for 1 minute. Increase the speed to medium and beat 2 minutes more. The batter should look thick and well combined. Fold in the chocolate chips and pecans. Spoon the batter into the prepared pan and place in the oven.
- 3. B ake until it is lightly browned, 42 to 46 minutes. Remove from oven and place on wire rack to cool for 20 minutes. Run a long, sharp knife around the edge of the cake and invert it onto aa rack to cool completely, 20 minutes more.
- 4. Slide the cake onto a serving platter and dust with confectioners' sugar, and slice.
- 5. Store thi cake, wrapped in foil or plastic wrap, or in a cake saver, at room temperature for up to 1 week. Or freeze it for up to 6 months.
